The new geophysics unit with state of the art equipment, based in Orkney, will operate across the Highlands and Islands Region and beyond. The primary focus of the unit will be archaeological geophysics but we are looking for applicants who would also be interested in exploring innovative and diverse uses of the technology in other fields. The successful geophysicist will also contribute to the delivery of a Masters degree in Archaeological Practice based at the College.

The Geophysicist salary will be in the range £22,452 to £29,280 and the Geophysics Technician salary will be in the range £16,356 to £18,099 pro rata, dependent on qualifications and experience.
